## OBSERVATIONS OF FLAWLESS DESIGN

### A statement from George Freedman of PTW interiors

The original purpose and function of this building, to receive equipment and products to meet the needs of a burgeoning Australian Navy, is a compelling inspiration for the interior design of living space for a new millennium.

Where large crates and containers once filled the broad expanses through the building, the interiors of these sophisticated new environments are to translate the concept of transient elements arriving and departing the architectural space by conceiving all individual elements as independent units.

Kitchens and storage spaces, quoting this original function, will artfully appear as free standing timber elements.

The richness of oak joinery and floor finishes will reflect the predominance of this robust timber's use for luxury interiors in bygone eras and provide a lustrous platform for living spaces against pale grey columns and ceilings.

Acknowledging its prominence in naval design throughout the ages, polished brass will provide gleaming features of form and function throughout every apartment.

When not bathed in natural light, the living spaces will be suffused in the soft glow of indirect lighting embedded in the timber floors and discreetly positioned behind joinery heads.

The waterfront vista every apartment will enjoy, is echoed in the design intent of bathrooms' blue mosaic patterned walls and master bedrooms' gloss white that reflect the hues of a clear Sydney summer sky and glitter of the expansive harbour.
